

Planning Area

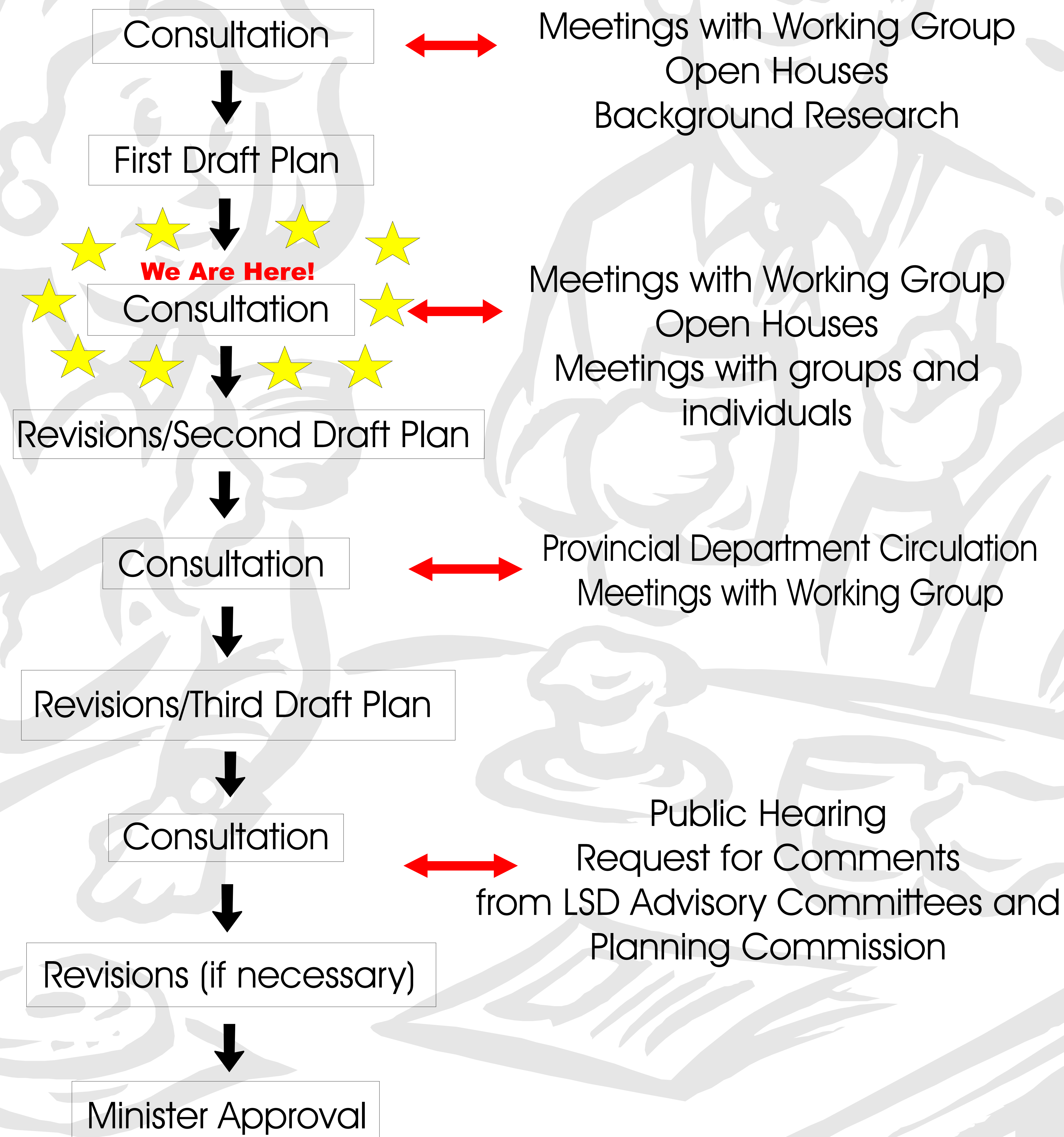
The Lower Kennebecasis Planning Area consists of the Local Service Districts of Kingston, Rothesay, Hampton, Norton, and the Westfield East.

The Planning Area includes the drainage basin of the lower portion of the Kennebecasis River. It also covers a small portion of the Hammond River Watershed. Covering 520 km², the Planning Area has a strong rural character and is dominated economically by agriculture and resource-based activities.

The proposed policies and zones of the Lower Kennebecasis Rural Plan place a heavy emphasis on maintaining the region's productive resource base and ensuring the long-term economic, social, and environmental health of the Planning Area and its residents.
