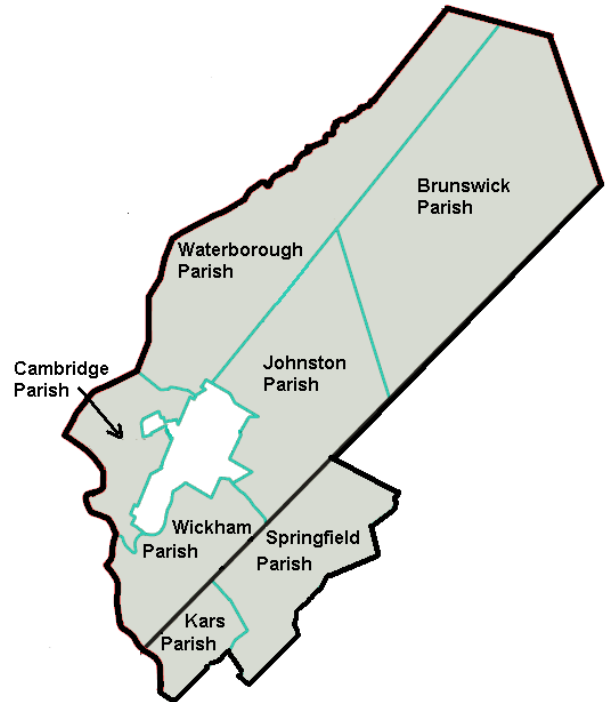
The Royal District Planning Commission is beginning to develop a Rural Plan for the Saint John Tributaries Planning Area, which includes the Local Service Districts (LSDs) of Brunswick, Cambridge, Johnston, Kars, Springfield, Waterborough, and Wickham.

A Working Group of residents and technical advisers has been established to provide guidance and give advice to the planners throughout the planning process with regards to the community and its needs.

The purpose of the Open House Information Sessions is to give residents an opportunity to learn more about the planning process, the information gathered to date, and to have input on important land use issues. LSD Representatives, Working Group members and Planning Commission staff will be present to address any questions or concerns related to the Rural Plan and the planning process.

What is a Rural Plan?

A rural plan contains long-term objectives and policies to guide future land use development in the Planning Area. It also include various land use zones which will be identified on a Zone Map, as well as a list of permitted uses and standards for development within each of these zones.



Why should I attend this Open House?

The Planning Commission and Working Group are seeking resident and landowner input as we proceed with the development of the Rural Plan. This Open House will give you an opportunity to get more details about the Rural Planning process.
