There are opportunities throughout the planning process for the public to provide input.

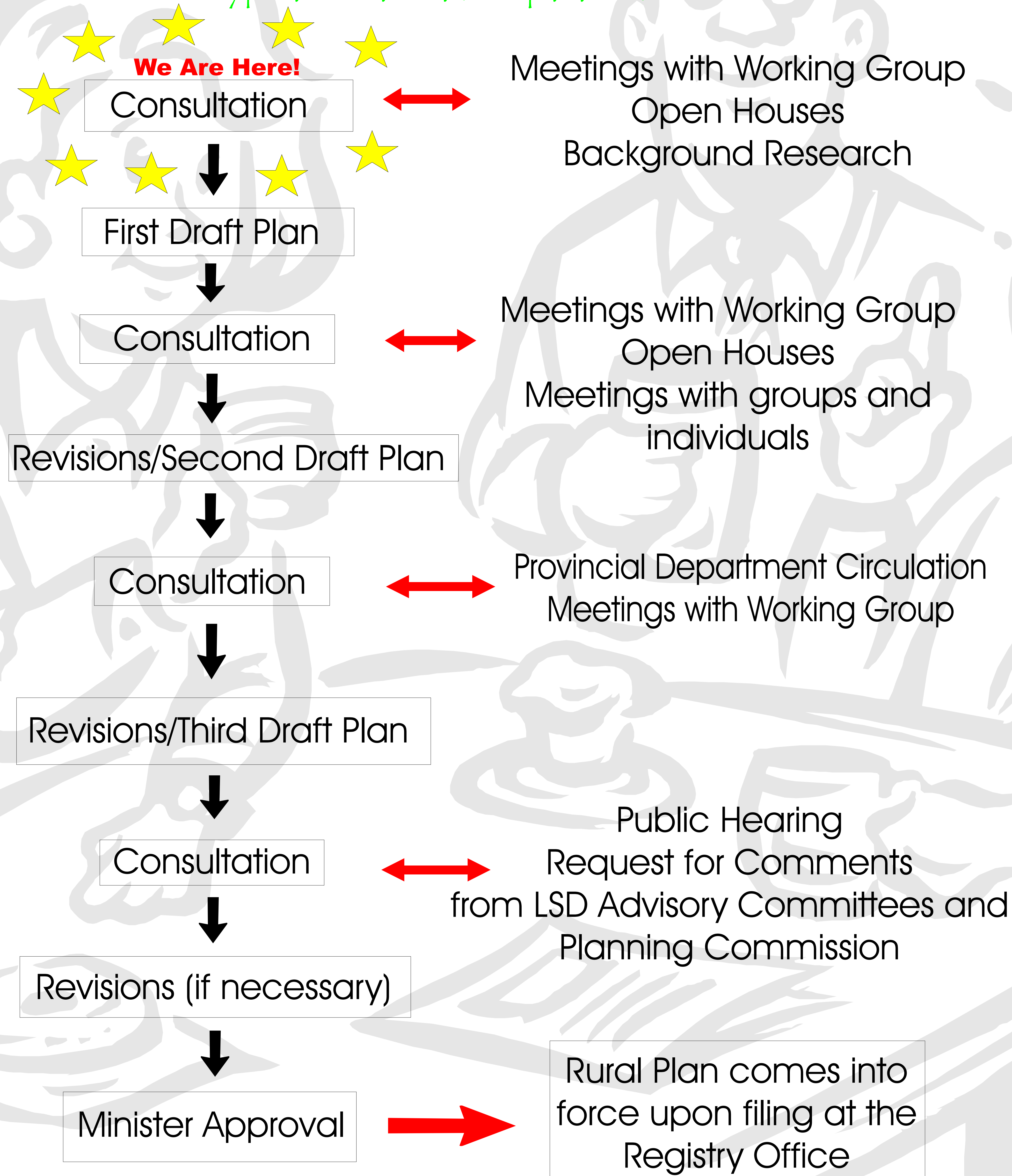
Early on in the planning process, open houses are held to ask residents to identify land issues important in their community.

Later on in the planning process additional open houses will be organized so residents can provide input on the draft Plan and on the proposed zoning of their property.

Planners are also available throughout the planning process to meet individually with residents and landowners who need more information or wish to provide more detailed input on the draft Plan. Residents are also encouraged to send their comments in writing.
